of meeting EACH of the criteria outlined below**

- 1 **\$120.00 Annual fee**
- 2 **Two supporting document's from the following criteria:**
- 13 week consecutive minimum rental contract.
 - Employment contract from your employer stating full time employment for a term not less than 13 weeks consecutively inclusive of "on mountain" accommodation.
 - Enrolment confirmation letter from one of the three schools operating within Alpine Central.
 - Mt Buller mailing address or re-direction to Mt Buller Post Office for a term not less than 13 consecutive weeks.
 - Electoral enrolment in the State area of Benalla.
 - Driver's licence with a Mt Buller Alpine Resort address.
 - Statutory declaration dated and signed by the applicant confirming occupancy of premises for a minimum of 5 days per week on the mountain for a term not less than 13 weeks consecutive (leased or sub-leased by themselves or his/her spouse or resident children) and having a Mt Buller mailing address re-direction to Mt Buller Post Office for a term not less than 13 consecutive weeks.
- 3 **Supporting documents to be supplied by Body Corporate Apartment owner (s)**
- If you are renting the apartment, written consent from the apartment owner and;
 - If your property is controlled or administered by a body corporate, supporting documentation from the body corporate permitting your dog onto the site;
 - Written confirmation of the unanimous consent of all apartment owners on the site.
- 4 **Provide current details of your dog's registration and where, outside Mt Buller Alpine Resort** (a letter from your Vet stating dog's name, sex, breed and if it is de-sexed will suffice).

Please note this permit is for an individual dog, not the owner.
