The new \$1.6m investment can continuously produce snow 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and can do so at temperatures well above freezing. The 'Snow Factory' is capable of generating 220 cubic meters of snow daily at 15 degrees Celsius, which will enable Buller to begin snowmaking in May 2017 to guarantee skiing on Bourke Street for opening weekend. No other resort in Australia has the capabilities to produce snow at such high temperatures, nor can any other resort offer such an outstanding snow guarantee to ensure you can book your trip with complete confidence.

BOOKING YOUR SCHOOLS TRIP

At Buller Holidays we are now able to organise every aspect of your schools trip, from Lift, Lesson and Rental products, to Accommodation, Meals, Transport and Resort Entry.

Follow the booking steps below to ensure your schools trip to Mt Buller is as smooth as possible. Should you have any questions or require any further information, please call our bookings team at Buller Holidays.

1. Familiarise yourself with the products we are able to offer to ensure you get the most out of your schools trip. For more information about Mt Buller visit <u>www.mtbuller.com.au</u> or <u>www.bullerholidays.com.au</u>.

2. To get your preferred dates and lesson times, it is vital that you book as early as possible to avoid disappointment. The ski and snowboard school conducts school group lessons at 8:30am, 10:00am, 11:30am and 1:30pm daily. The morning lessons run for 1.5 hours and afternoon lessons are 2 hours. The 3 hour lesson option, available during off-peak periods will be conducted at 9:00am and 1:30pm.

To assign students into these school group lessons we require at least 8 students of the same ability/ discipline, if you have less than 8 students they will be assigned into public lessons. If your students are assigned into public lessons, information on when and where your students will need to meet will be included in your confirmation letter.

Use the below guide to determine your students' abilities:

ABILITY	LEVEL NUMBER	DESCRIPTION
FIRST TIME SKIER OR SNOWBOARDER	1	Never skied or snowboarded before.
BEGINNER	2 – 3	Can link turns on green runs.
INTERMEDIATE	4 - 6	Comfortable skiing or riding in control on blue runs

Please note: You may choose a preferred lesson time; however during peak times we may not be able to give you your first choice. The 1:30pm lesson time is a benefit during busy periods, especially for first time or beginner students as it often provides a more generous student to instructor ratio with an extended duration of 2 hours.

3. Once you have chosen lesson times, dates and student/ teacher numbers download and complete the **2017 Schools Booking form.** Please ensure students full names, DOB's, chosen discipline, ability level and rental data is included on the booking form. We require this information to create a booking for you.

If you are interested in any of the additional products Buller Holidays are able to offer you; Transport, Gate entry, Accommodation or meals. Please select the drop-downs on the booking form, a Buller Holidays agent will contact you with information and applicable quotes.

Please note: Free of charge teachers are at a ratio of **1:8** for secondary students and **1:5** for primary students (Lift, rental and lunch can be included for a FOC teacher.)

4. After completing your booking form with all the requested information, send it through to us at <u>bookings@bullerholidays.com.au</u> for us to create your Schools order. We also require a signed copy of the **Acceptance of all Terms and Conditions and Acknowledgement of Ticket Waiver** (*Found on the last page of this planner*) to be emailed though to us with the booking form.

*A Buller Holidays agent will contact you if there are any issues in regards to availability.

5. Upon entering your booking into the system Buller Holidays will issue you with a **confirmation letter**. An invoice will also be generated at the time of confirmation; you can expect to receive the invoice within 2-3 business days. The **full booking amount** must be received **14 days prior** to your arrival; if full payment is not received your reserved lessons will be released and your order cancelled.



BOOKING INFORMATION

CHOOSING RENTAL LOCATIONS

To make rental collection easy for your group, Mt Buller offers at a number of different rental locations so you can choose which will be more suitable for your group.

Buller Sports Mansfield – This location offers the most space out of the Buller Sports stores, and is ideal for large groups visiting for the day or for groups staying off-mountain.

Buller Sports Central – Located centrally in the Village, ideal for groups staying on-mountain or small groups that are just travelling for the day.

Buller Sports Horse Hill - Located in the day car park this convenient location allows access directly to the North side Express chairlift. (*Note: Lessons can be conducted from North side by request.*)

TICKET COLLECTION

B-tags/Lift passes and lesson tickets are collected and signed out from Buller Sports Mansfield, Buller Sports Horse Hill or at the Buller Holidays office, which is located in the Village Ticket Office or 'Saleyards" which is in the heart of the Mt Buller village.

ALLOW PLENTY OF TIME FOR YOUR TRIP

The trip up to Mt Buller can take longer than expected, please allow extra time as the road conditions can vary drastically. Heavy snow on the road can add an extra 30-45 minutes, so to ensure a smooth start to your trip it is recommended you book a later lesson time on your first day to also allow time for rental collection.

CHANGES TO YOUR BOOKING

We know changes to your snow trip can be inevitable, to accommodate these changes we are happy to accept any increase or decrease in numbers provided to us in writing up to a week prior to your arrival. (*This also applies to cancellations.*)

Should any decrease in numbers arise (within 7 days) due to medical issues, we will offer a refund or credit for the individuals unused snow products upon sighting of a valid medical certificate.

Lesson changes are at the discretion of the School Groups co-ordinator, during peak times lesson changes may not be accepted.

BEFORE YOUR ARRIVAL

Prior to your arrival to Mt Buller, it is highly recommended to check our website <u>www.mtbuller.com.au</u> for all the latest snow and weather conditions, and the latest news that may be applicable to your trip. It is important students and teachers are prepared for the changing weather conditions an alpine environment like Mt Buller may encounter. IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY – WAIVER OF RIGHT TO SUE – YOUR ASSUMPTION OF RISK – THESE CONDITIONS AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

Buller Ski Lifts Pty Ltd being the Supplier of recreational services in the Mount Buller Alpine Resort sells all access products, including tickets and Buller Passes, that provide the purchaser with access to all ski lifts and ski/snowboard slopes in the Resort on a daily or multi day basis and supplies all recreational services including skiing, snowboarding, tobogganing, snowtubing, skiing and snowboarding lessons, snow making, snow grooming, the use of chair lifts, t-bars, moving carpet, rope tows, operations of the ski patrol, the condition, layout, design, construction, maintenance, grooming and use of ski/snowboard slopes and surrounds (including the presence of people or objects thereon or nearby) and all other associated sporting activities or similar leisure time pursuits (recreational activities) subject to the following conditions:

- 1. By participating in any recreational activities or by using any of the above facilities or services in the Mount Buller Alpine Resort you are deemed to agree to these conditions.
- 2. The Supplier, its employees, directors and agents are not liable to you, your dependants or legal representatives for personal injury or death suffered by you due to the recreational activities not being supplied with due care and skill or not being reasonably fit for their purpose or for breach of any other of the consumer guarantees applied by the Australian Consumer Law (Victoria), or due to the negligence, breach of contract or statute or statutory duty by the Supplier.
- 3. You acknowledge that the recreational activities are dangerous with many risks and hazards and as a consequence personal injury and sometimes death can occur and you assume and accept all such risks and hereby waive the right to sue the Supplier for any personal injury or death in any way whatsoever caused by or arising from your participation in such activities;
- 4. WARNING: If you participate in these activities your rights to sue the Supplier under the Australian Consumer Law & Fair Trading Act 2012 if you are killed or injured because the activities were not supplied with due care and skill or were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in paragraphs 2 and 3 of this notice.
- 5. NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in or on this notice, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the Supplier's part. Gross negligence, in relation to an act or omission, means doing the act or omitting to do an act with reckless disregard, with or without consciousness, for the consequences of the act or omission. See regulation 5 of the Australian Consumer Law & Fair Trading Regulations 2012 and section 23(3)(b) of the Australian Consumer Law & Fair Trading Act 2012.
- 6. If you purchase any access product or recreational service from the Supplier on behalf of another person, you make that purchase as the agent of the other person who as a consequence is bound by these conditions.
- 7. You must comply with the Alpine Responsibility Code and all signs or other directions of the Supplier, its employees and agents and they may suspend or cancel your access to recreational activities at the Mount Buller Alpine Resort in their absolute discretion for non-compliance with the Code, these conditions, or for reckless or careless conduct.
- 8. You must carry your Buller Ski Lifts Pty Ltd access product/ Buller Pass in or on your ski jacket at all times on the ski/snowboard slopes which must be presented to the Supplier's authorised personnel upon request.
- 9. All Buller Ski Lifts Pty Ltd access products/Buller Passes must not be resold, transferred or altered in any manner. They are valid only for the dates purchased. The Supplier will not refund or replace any access product/Buller Pass if it is lost, if you suffer any illness or injury or if any lift service is not operating.
- 10. These conditions shall be governed by and construed firstly in accordance with the laws of the State of Victoria and then in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Australia. If any of these conditions should be determined to be void, invalid or otherwise unenforceable, it shall be deemed deleted and the remaining conditions shall remain and continue to be valid, binding and enforceable.

- 1. All clients purchasing lift and/or lesson and sightseer tickets through the Operator will be given a complete copy of the ticket waiver (as on following page) governing the purchase and use of such prior to the time of purchase.
- 2. Should my business fail to comply with the agreement in paragraph 1 and as a consequence Buller Ski Lifts Pty. Ltd. is unable to rely upon these Terms and Conditions as a defence to any claim or legal proceedings for personal injury or death brought against Buller Ski Lifts by any client or his/her dependants, I will fully and completely indemnify and keep indemnified Buller Ski Lifts against all such claims or legal proceedings up to a maximum limit of \$100,000.00 per claim.
- 3. I agree and confirm that my business has in place, and will retain for the 2017 winter season, a contract of insurance with a reputable insurance company or underwriter which will indemnify it for all and any liability that I may at any time have to Buller Ski Lifts Pty. Ltd. for breach of any term of the agreement as set out in this letter. Upon request I will provide Buller Ski Lifts Pty. Ltd. with a Certificate of Insurance confirming the existence of such an insurance contract.
