

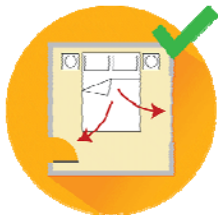
RESORT ACCOMMODATION FIRE SAFETY TIPS



Know where the fire exits, fire stairs and fire fighting equipment are located



NEVER prop open or block exits or leave anything in fire stairs



Make and practice an escape plan. Decide on a safe meeting place away from the building and out of the cold.



DO NOT overcrowd. Too many people living in one room increases the fire risk



Get out, stay out and call Triple Zero (000). Never go back inside a burning building

Never leave electrically-powered appliances on bedding



- Turn on 30 minutes before getting into bed.
- Turn off once you are in bed.



Replace your smoke alarms every ten years

Attack fire if safe to do so

Evacuate to assembly area

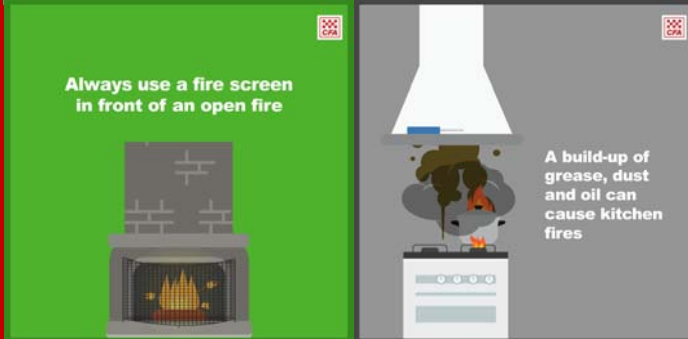
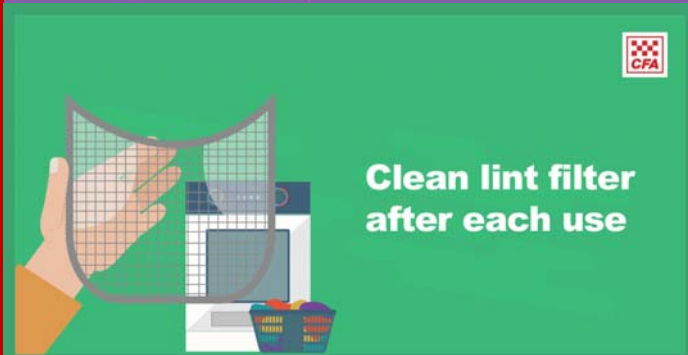
