

Grease and Fats

The Mt Buller waste water treatment plant is unable to treat grease and fats. Grease and fats that are poured into the sewage system can cause the treatment plant to malfunction and stop effectively treating waste water.

GET ON BOARD TO REDUCE GREASE AND FATS ENTERING THE WASTE WATER SYSTEM

The Resort's kitchens, private and commercial, are by far the greatest sources of unwanted grease and fats.

You can help by having suitable containers readily accessible for you and your staff to scrape fats and grease from pots, pans, plates and utensils into prior to washing.

Mt Buller has a grease and fat recycling operation.

Containers should be placed in the Garbage Collection Sheds or Commercial Collection Points for transport from Mt Buller to the Waste Transfer Station at Boggy Corner.

With your help the problem of fats and grease in waste water can be virtually eliminated and your part has been played in the flow on effect of keeping our water clean for recycling and the environment.
