

Official Rules – Mt Buller Peak Pics 2019

Introduction

The Mount Buller and Mount Stirling Resort Management (RMB) is again hosting a photography competition: **Peak Pics - Mt Buller's Photography Competition 2019** (Peak Pics) featuring photos with the theme '**All the Colours**'.

The Competition

Peak Pics opens 7.00am Saturday 8th June and closes 12.00pm Sunday 8th September 2019.

- 1 **Peak Pics** incorporates five categories as follows: a) People b) Landscape c) Action d) Light e) Stunning Mt Stirling
- 2 The overarching theme for 2019 is '**All the Colours**'
- 3 No more than **three** photos per category will be accepted from each photographer.
- 4 All entrants must agree to accept these terms and conditions.
- 5 All images must be taken within the Mt Buller & Mt Stirling Alpine Resort.
- 6 All images must be taken in the 2019 calendar year.
- 7 Instagram images will NOT be accepted.
- 8 While images from mobile devices may meet the image size criteria (see below) we highly recommend the use of Digital SLR cameras to achieve a superior quality photograph

Terms and Conditions of Entry

- 7 Entry to the Peak Pics Competition is free.
- 8 Entries must be the original work and bona fide property of the entrant.
- 9 The RMB retains the right to publish any submitted photo on the www.mtbuller.com.au website, in electronic and printed promotional material for Mt Buller – Mt Stirling, as well as exhibition spaces. No payment will be made for the use of the copyright.
- 10 Entrants shall allow their photo to be displayed on the Mt Buller website **www.mtbuller.com.au** and Mt Buller Facebook page for the duration of the competition. Winning photographs will be displayed on the website at the conclusion of the competition.
- 11 Entrants accept and acknowledge that their work may be reproduced in local and national publications promoting Mt Buller and Mt Stirling.

Submitting Entries

- 12 All details regarding submission of entries will be on Peaks Pics page on **www.mtbuller.com.au**.
- 13 Method of submission is via the Mt Buller Facebook Photo Competition.

- 14 Entrants must be able to provide a high resolution version (greater than 2MB) should they be chosen as a winner. If an entrant cannot provide a high resolution image, and another winner will be chosen.

Judging and Prizes

- 15 A Selection Committee will shortlist entries in each category prior to submission of images to the judging panel.
- 16 The Committee will comprise of no less than three judges.
- 17 The Judging Committee will select three finalists including one winner in each of the five categories.
- 18 The People's Choice Award will be for the image with the most number of votes received via the online competition portal.
- 19 The overall winner will be chosen by the judging panel from the category winning images and the People's Choice winner
- 20 The judges' decision is final and no correspondence shall be entered into.
- 21 The winners will be announced at the via the Mt Buller Facebook and website (www.mtbuller.com.au) on Monday 23 September 2019. Winners will be notified by phone and/or email prior to the Monday 23 September 2019 announcement.
- 22 Prizes will be given for first place in each category, including the People's Choice Award. The overall winner will receive a 2020 Mt Buller resort entry and parking pass and their choice of a new pair of skis or snowboard thanks to our mountain partner K2. Each category winner (including the People's Choice) will receive a complimentary prize thanks to our mountain partner K2. Winner's will be notified on how to collect their prize closer to the date.
- 23 The People's Choice Award will be for the image with the most number of votes received via the online competition portal/app.

The Exhibition

- 24 Any entry may be selected for inclusion in the Peak Pics Exhibition. In previous years the top three entries in each category have been exhibited along with the People's Choice winner.
- 25 Photos will be reproduced and framed for the Exhibition. The Mt Buller and Mt Stirling Resort Management remains the owner of these reproductions. At the conclusion of the Exhibition winning exhibited works may be sold. Any funds raised will be used for the promotion and development of the event. The owner of the photo has no rights to this revenue.
- 26 Photos chosen for the Peak Pics Exhibition will be displayed in Alpine Central at a date to be determined.
