FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

Vehicle Season Pass

• Should I buy a vehicle season pass?

The vehicle season pass gives access to both Mt Buller and Mt Stirling throughout the entire snow season. It's a great option for people who make frequent trips to the resort for convenience and to potentially save money.

• Can I use the same pass for multiple vehicles?

No, the season pass is not transferable and can only be allocated to the registration of a single vehicle

• Can I access the Mt Buller Village with this pass?

No, the season pass provides access to the day and overnight car parks only and does not permit access to Mt Buller village.

• How do I collect my vehicle season pass?

The season pass is a windscreen sticker. It's mailed to your address during the month of May. If purchased after 31 May, passes can be collected from Resort Entry gate at Mirimbah.

Vehicle Season Pass - reservations for day visits on weekends

Why do I have to reserve entry on weekends for a day visit?

On weekends Mt Buller's day car parks often reach capacity. Estimating the number of parking spaces needed for Season Pass holders is increasingly challenging and there is a risk that season pass holders visiting for the day could miss out on a parking bay and therefore not be permitted entry into the resort.

Reserve your entry, print the reservation dashboard pass to display with your windscreen sticker and you're on your way!

Is there a cost for reserving entry?

If arriving on the weekend and staying overnight, do I need to reserve entry?
 Reserving entry is required on weekends for day visits only. If you are staying overnight there is no need to reserve entry.

• I have reserved entry, where do I park?

Park where directed by the parking attendants as multiple car parks are filled simultaneously on weekends.

- If I don't reserve entry on a weekend in advance, can I still visit?
 - If the resorts have not reached capacity in day car parks, entry is permitted. In this instance, vehicles are required to collect a dashboard pass from Entry gate at Mirimbah.
- If the resort has reached capacity and I haven't reserved entry, can I still visit?
 Once day car parks have reached capacity, vehicles will <u>not</u> be permitted to enter the resorts including Season Pass holders.
- What should I do if a reserve entry and then change my mind?
 Cancellations are permitted until 12pm on the Friday before arrival. Failing to cancel may impact ability to make future reservations. Cancellations are made via email to parking@mtbuller.com.au
- Is there any consequence from reserving entry and not showing up?

 Season Passes may be suspended or cancelled for three or more 'no shows' (i.e. reservation made and not validated).
- Will I be charged the printing fee if I don't have a reserved dashboard pass when I arrive at Mirimbah Entry Gate?

No. However, printing the dashboard pass before arriving at Mirimbah Entry is highly recommended for a contactless journey to the day car parks.

- Can I transfer the reserved dashboard pass to another vehicle?
 - No. Dashboard passes are linked to the Season Pass vehicle registration and cannot be transferred between vehicles. If you decide to travel in another vehicle, purchasing Resort Entry will be required.
- How far ahead of the weekend can I reserve entry?
 Reservations are open for the entire season and can be made up until day of arrival.
